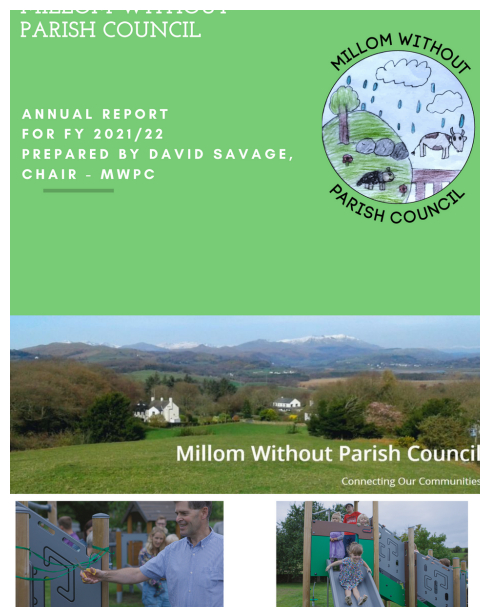
The Bus Shelters will provide an information hub for both Villages, with new notice boards on order to complete this project.

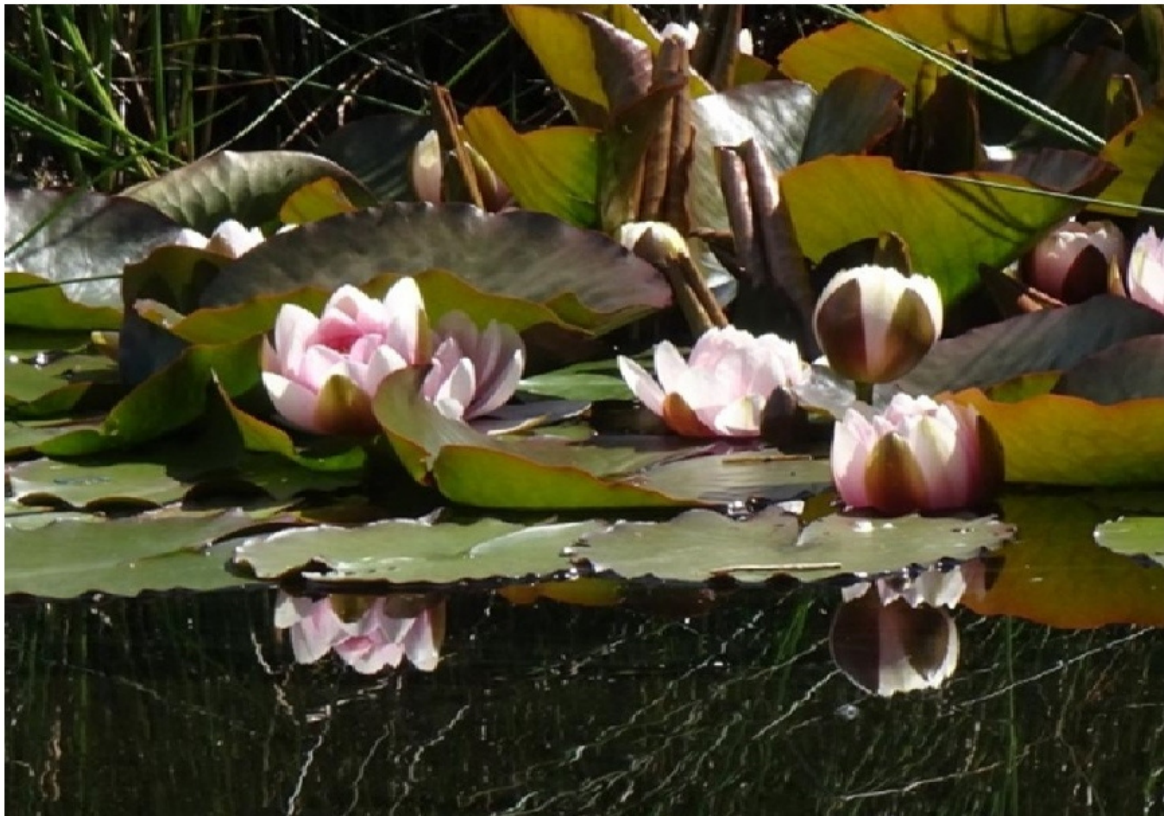
